Urine For Cytology Collection

- 1. Urine samples for cytology are optimal if repeated on three (3) consecutive days. Do not collect more than one sample per day.
- 2. Discard your first urine of the day. DO NOT KEEP THIS URINE.
- 3. When the next urge to urinate arises collect the specimen as follows (Note: you may drink a glass of water every 30 minutes over a 3 hour period if needed to obtain the specimen.):
 - Remove the lid from the specimen container making sure not to touch or contaminate the inside of the lid or container.
 - <u>Females:</u> Before urinating, labia must be spread apart Males: Before urinating, foreskin (if present) must be retracted.
 - "Midstream Urine" process: **Begin urinating into the toilet** and then move the container into the urine stream to collect the sample.
 - Fill the container to at least half full.
 - Replace the lid tightly on the container.
 - Write your full name, date of birth and Health Card (OHIP) number, date and time collected on the container.
 - Place the specimen container in a zip-lock transport bag and seal it.
 - Keep the sample upright to avoid leakage/spills.
 - Refrigerate the sample if you are not delivering it to the lab immediately.
 - You must transport this sample to a Laboratory Specimen Collection Centre within 12-hours.
